

The Paris Air Show is the most important international event for Aeronautics and Space in the world. Every two years it brings together the leading manufacturers, technologies and players of this global industry. This edition is gathering 2,400 exhibitors from 50 countries, more than 3,000 accredited journalists and 290 official delegations from more than 90 countries and is expected to surpass the figure of 300,000 visitors who attended the last one. As at previous shows, more than 150 aircraft will be giving flight demonstrations in the afternoons. The first four days are reserved for professional visitors and the following three the show is open to the general public.

In the afternoon the stand of Hegan, the Basque Country aeronautical cluster, has celebrated the region's Euskadi Day with the presence of the Basque Government's Vice Councillor for Industry, Javier Zarraonandía, and the Director of Basque Trade & Investment, Aihnoa Ondarzabal.

Tomorrow, 18 June, the Spanish Pavilion will be celebrating Spanish Aeronautical Day which will be attended by the Minister of Science and Technology, Pedro Duque. The companies will also receive a visit from Spain's ambassador in Paris, as well as a large group from the Ministry of Defence, led by the Director General of Armaments and Materiel, from the Secretary General of Industry and SMEs, and the Director General of the Centre for Industrial Technological Development (CDTI), among other institutional representatives.
